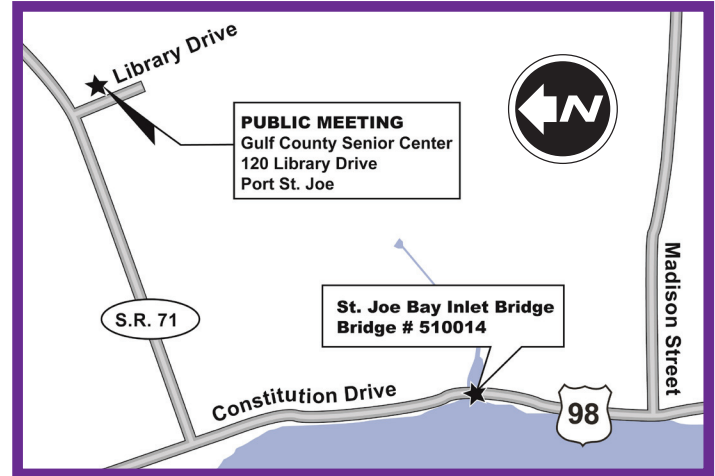

### Project Information

The intent of this project is to replace the existing bridge on U.S. 98 over Saint Joe Bay Inlet with a new concrete structure. Improvements include new guardrail, minor drainage improvements, sodding, and placement of new pavement markings. Additional right-of-way and temporary construction easements may be required for construction of the proposed bridge. Bids for construction are scheduled to be received summer 2019.

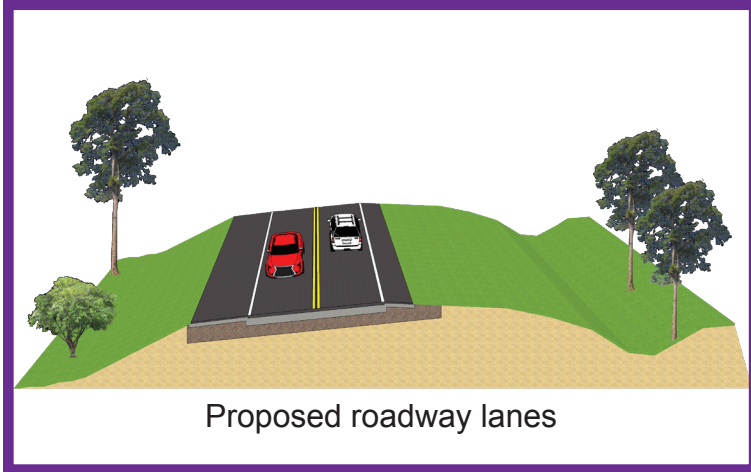

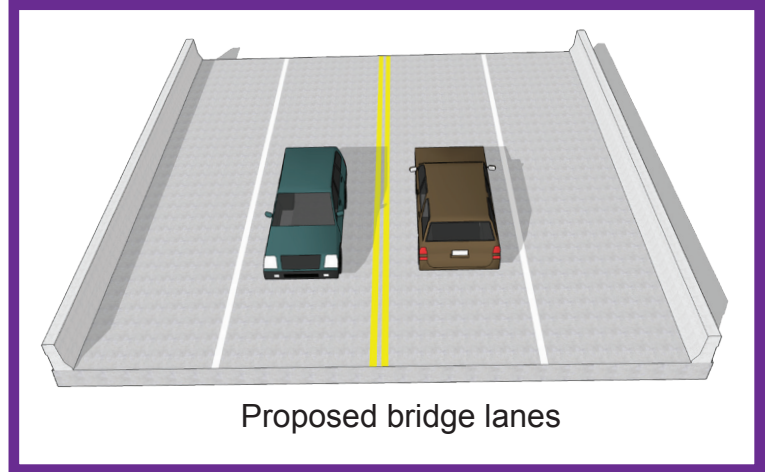
## ➔ Typical Sections



### Roadway Typical Section

The two-lane rural typical section has the following features:

- Two twelve foot wide travel lanes in each direction
- A ten foot wide shoulder on the east - five foot wide paved shoulder and five foot sodded
- A ten foot wide paved shoulder on the west
- Open ditch drainage



### Bridge Typical Section

The two-lane bridge typical section has the following features:

- Two twelve foot wide travel lanes in each direction
- Ten foot wide shoulders in each direction



Existing bridge



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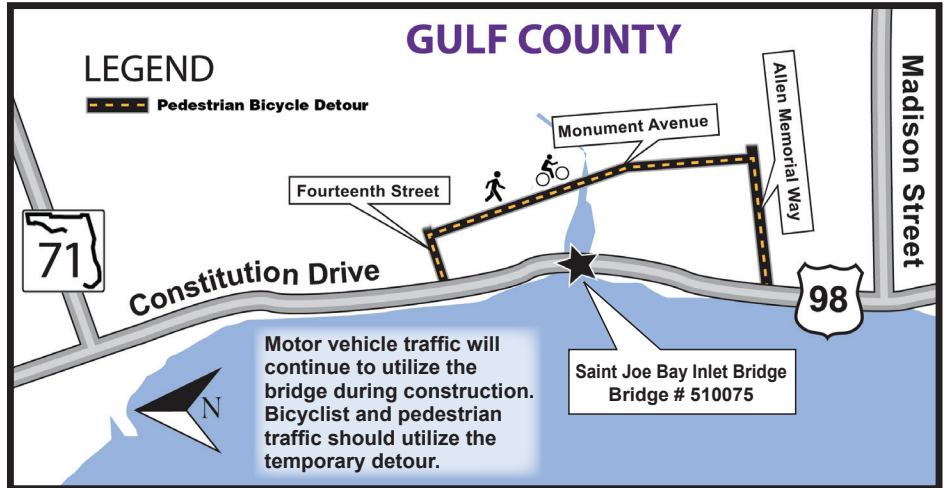
# CONSTRUCTION BEGINS



## CONSTRUCTION WILL BEGIN JANUARY 23 ON SAINT JOE BAY INLET BRIDGE, GULF COUNTY

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will construct a new bridge over Saint Joe Bay Inlet on U.S. 98 to replace the existing bridge. Improvements include new guardrails, drainage, pavement markings, and sodding. Existing two-way travel will be maintained during construction. A pedestrian bicycle detour from Fourteenth Street to Allen Memorial Way will be available for cyclists and pedestrians during construction. Additional right-of-way and temporary construction easements will be required. Work is scheduled to be complete spring 2021.

Motorists are reminded to pay attention to the speed limit when traveling through the construction area, to watch for construction equipment entering and leaving the roadway, and to use caution when driving through the work zone. Speeding fines are doubled when workers are present. All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather.

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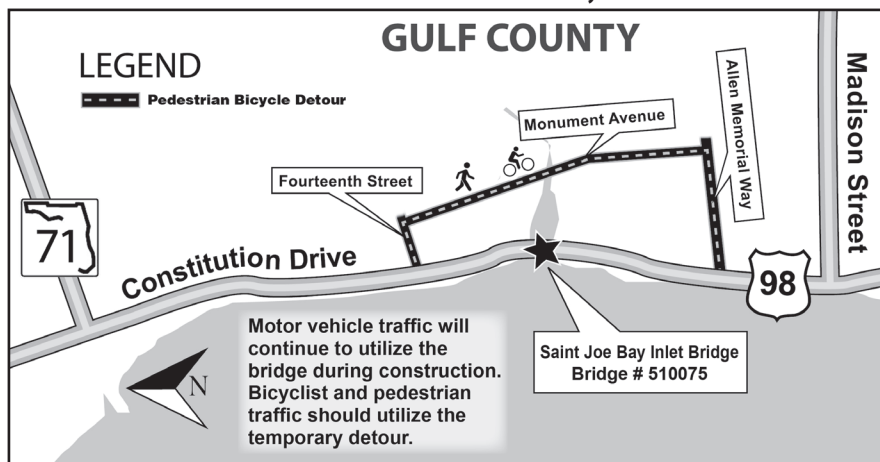
