

Project Information

The intent of this project is to resurface existing travel lanes, auxiliary lanes, and construct four-foot paved shoulders in each direction.

Additional improvements include:


- 1. New mast arms at Blue Angel Parkway intersection
- 2. Southbound, right turn lane extension at Blue Angel Parkway
- 3. Signal improvements at Fairfield Drive
- 4. Drainage improvements



Existing Fairfield Drive




- 11-foot travel lanes
