
Safety Improvements



From Chemstrand Road to Baldridge Drive, Escambia County

Project Information:

The intent of this safety improvement project is to upgrade traffic signals and install lighting at all signalized intersections, remove acceleration lanes, and construct offset left turn lanes; where feasible. In addition, right turn lanes will be widened to accommodate bicycle lanes.



Safety Improvements Include:

- Upgrade signalized intersections at Hummingbird Boulevard, Guidy Lane, Jernigan Road, Scenic Hills Drive, and Baldridge Drive
- Offset left turn lanes to improve sight distance
- Add keyhole bicycle lanes

Anticipated End Date: Fall 2023

Length: 2.3 miles


Safety Improvements



Traffic Impacts:

- Lane closures will only be allowed between the hours of 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Speed limits will remain the same during construction.
- Watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the work zone.

Proposed features on U.S. 90A (East Nine Mile Road) from County Road 749 (Chemstrand Road) to Baldridge Drive:

- Offset left turn lanes
- Four-foot traffic separators at left turn lanes
- Five-foot bicycle lanes through right turn lanes
- Existing roadside ditches to remain
