




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Historical Information

This Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) design project, known as Segment 8, is an outcome of the Gulf Coast Parkway Project Development and Environment Study (PD&E). The Gulf Coast Parkway PD&E study is planning a new 36-mile state road between Gulf and Bay counties. See the inside map for the proposed alignment and segment 8 location. The proposed alignment was approved by Gulf County in 2015 and Bay County in 2016. The Gulf Coast Parkway PD&E project is scheduled for completion

Project Information

The intent of this project is to construct a new two-lane rural roadway from U.S. 98 (Tyndall Parkway) to County Road (C.R.) 2315 (Star Avenue). Design improvements include a 10-foot multi-use path, new signalization at Tyndall Parkway and Star Avenue intersections, and connection to Tram Road north of the Veteran's Affairs Nursing Home. 






