



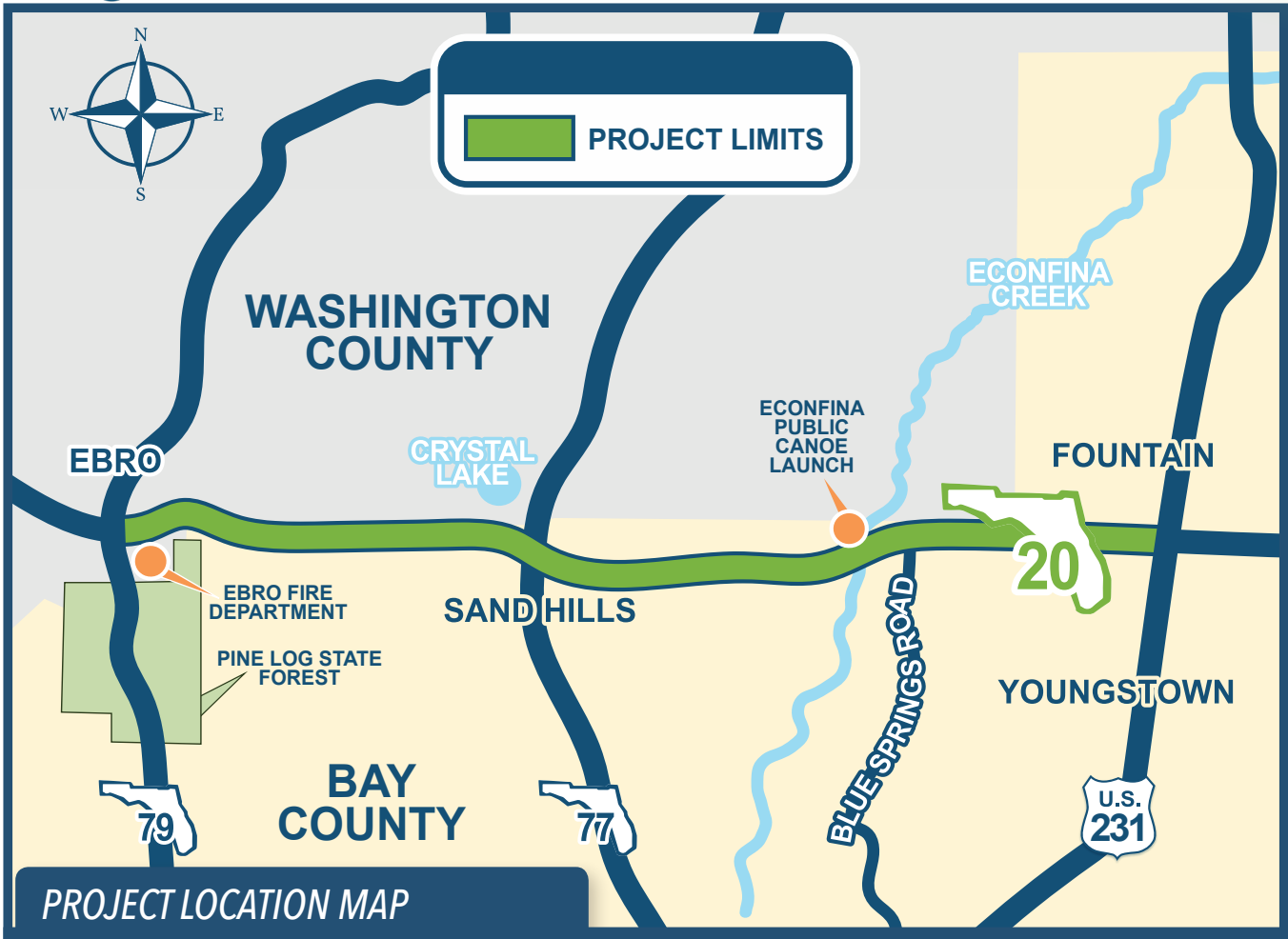

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study to consider reconstructing portions of State Road (S.R.) 20 from S.R. 79 to U.S. 231 in Washington and Bay counties to add capacity, enhance safety, and address flooding issues. These improvements consist of widening S.R. 20 from two to four lanes and elevating low-lying segments of the roadway prone to flooding. The study will develop and evaluate viable alternatives for these improvements, and will make recommendations to address existing and future needs. The total distance of this study is approximately 27 miles.

WHAT IS A PD&E STUDY?

A PD&E Study is the formal process that develops and compares alternatives to determine a preferred action that meets project goals, while minimizing impacts to the social, natural, and physical environments. Engaging the public by sharing and receiving information is a key component of this process and required by the National Environmental Policy Act.

WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT?

Over the next several months, FDOT will collect and analyze data to help compare the project alternatives. A virtual project update will be held to provide interested persons the most current information on the project and allow additional opportunity for public input. Details will be provided as they become available.
